You can download articles and pictures from the Internet and add them to your scrapbook.

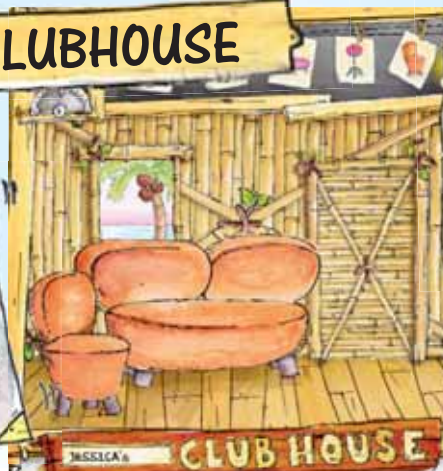
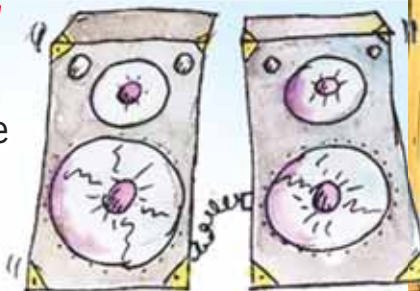
You can also print out your digital photographs, or cut them up and glue them in the book. Add your own colorful drawings. It's never too early to start leaving a record of your life!

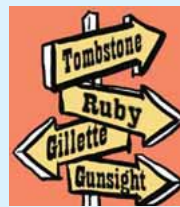
