## BEAUTIFYING BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF FULLERTON

American First Credit Union helped beautify and restore Boys & Girls Clubs across the City of Fullerton as part of its Community Service Day. With a group of 100+ volunteers working together for one cause, Credit Union associates fanned out across four sites. They painted walls, window trims and doors; raked leaves and planted succulents; scrubbed rails, walls and furniture; built and organized cabinets, shelves and desks, and so much more.

















### **RELAY FOR LIFE**

American First associates participated in the 24-hour walkathon in Buena Park to honor the lives lost to cancer, celebrate survivors, and support the caregivers who so selflessly help others. After weeks of fundraising, we raised \$20,000 for this year's Relay for Life, Wave Goodbye to Cancer.

### **BITE OF REALITY**






